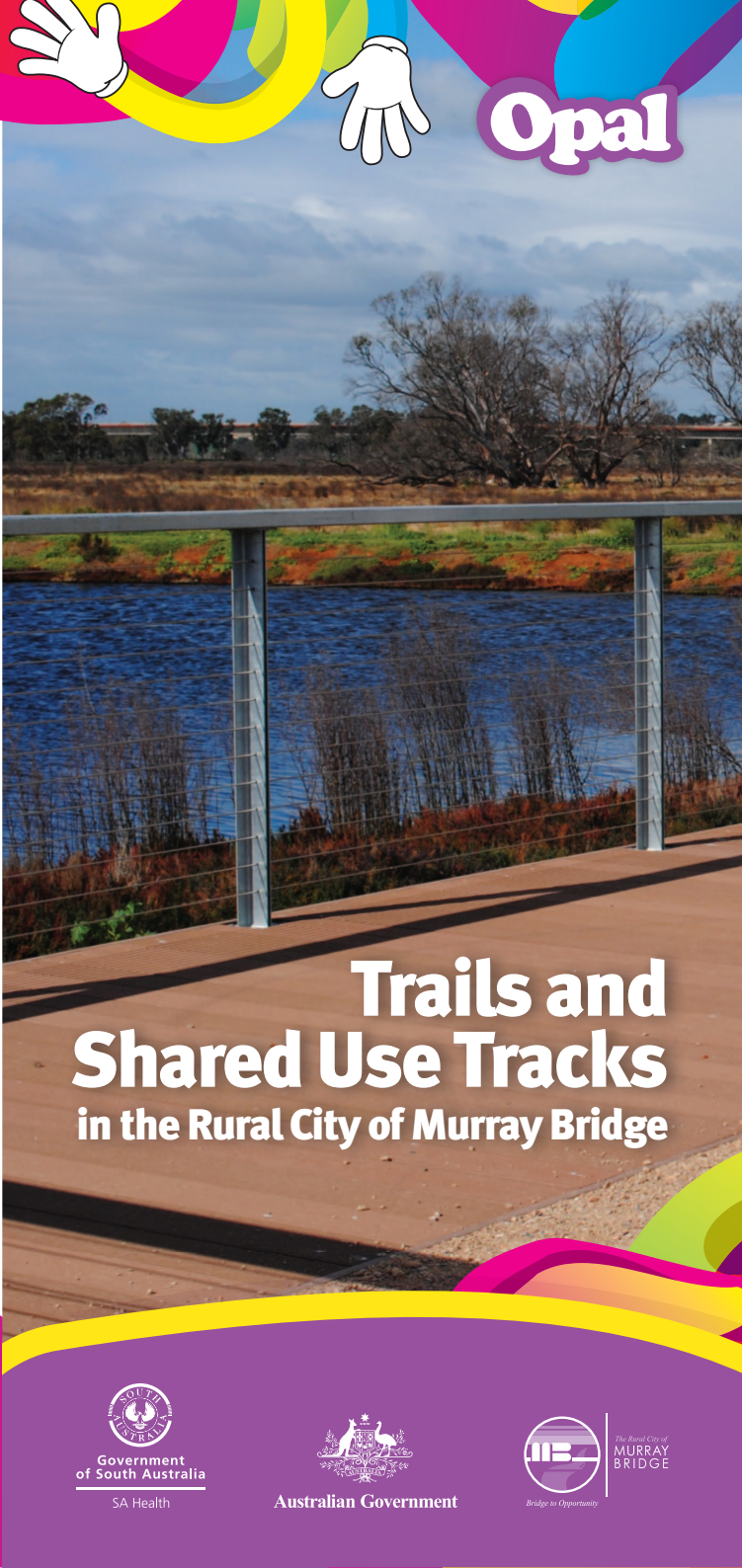

Trails and Shared Use Tracks in the Rural City of Murray Bridge

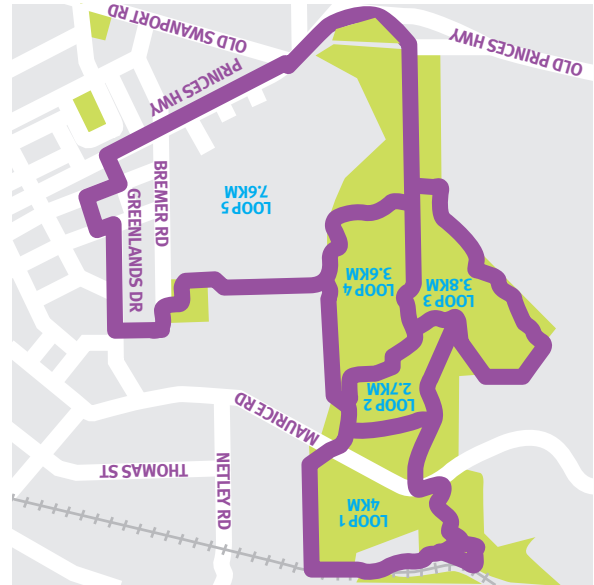


Information: Swanport Wetlands is a recreation reserve that covers an area of 19.4 hectares including 3.5 hectares of open water within a wetland.
